# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



## **How do I secure my wedding date?**

Once you have selected and communicated an available date for your event, our Event Director will send you an email with a personalized contract outlining your event information and deposit schedule. We will hold your date for 5 days in order to give you time to review and sign the contract and return it to us along with your deposit. Once the contract and deposit are processed, we will send you a follow up email confirming your date and providing any additional information you may need.

## **What is included in the site fee?**

The site fee includes use of the facilities for a wedding rehearsal, wedding-day use of facilities from 6 pm to 11 pm, with exclusive use of our grounds and picturesque vineyards for your bride and groom portrait session starting at 4:30 pm, plus use of our tower waiting area for the bridal party starting at 5:30 pm. The grounds include the Tower Lawn, Tower, Fountain Area, Lower Terraces, Aging Cellars, Picnic Area and Vittorio Terrace. The site fee also includes use of restroom facilities, tables (8 ft. banquet, 60" round and 30" bistros), ceremony and dining chairs, service staff, as well as substantial V. Sattui wine purchase discounts.





### **Where are the ceremony, cocktail hour, dinner and dancing held?**

For your ceremony, you may choose from our majestic tower lawn or the intimate courtyard (the rustic wine aging cellar may be used as a backup for ceremonies in case of inclement weather.) Your cocktail hour can take place on our lovely Vittorio Terrace, in our Courtyard or in the Cellar Club room. For dinner, guests are invited into the Barrel Aging Cellar and will continue to have use of the courtyard for the remainder of the event. The aging cellar also provides ample space for dancing and a band or DJ at your choosing.

### **How many guests may I invite?**

Our Courtyard can accommodate ceremonies of up to 135 people, while the Tower Lawn can accommodate 200 people.

### **Do I have to rent a tent in case of inclement weather?**

Our authentic Wine Aging Cellar is available and can serve as a backup if weather prevents use of a first choice outdoor location, saving you the significant cost and hassle of procuring a tent.

### **Do I have to rent a dance floor?**

The cellar floor is perfect for dancing, so there is no need for the added expense of a dance floor rental.

### **What if I have to cancel my event?**

Because weddings are generally booked significantly in advance, deposits are non-refundable. However, if we are able to rebook your date after cancellation, we will happily refund your deposit, less a 20% administrative fee.

### **How do I choose wines for my wedding?**

V. Sattui Winery is proud to offer over 70 varietals of incomparable wines carefully crafted by our award-winning winemaker. Your wedding liaison will arrange for you to have a complimentary wine tasting to choose which still and sparkling wines will best match your unique event, and wedding wine discounts will be provided. We will also help arrange for service of beer and other non-alcoholic beverages of your choosing.



## **How do I choose vendors for my event?**

With 40 plus years of wedding experience, V. Sattui has compiled a list of the Wine Country's best wedding professionals, including officiants, photographers, musicians, florists, etc. Your wedding liaison will be happy to answer questions you may have in choosing vendors from our list. ## **Who will be my caterer?**

V. Sattui is proud to offer our very own Michelin Star chef from the Lake Como region of Italy, Stefano Masanti. Chef Masanti has created fabulous menu offerings from which you can customize the wine country dinner that suits your event. Your wedding liaison will arrange for a complimentary menu tasting for bride and groom after securing your date with V. Sattui. Full menu pricing starts at \$155 per person.

## **Do I need to hire a wedding coordinator?**

While our event staff is happy to help with many aspects of planning your wedding, you are required to hire a day-of coordinator from V. Sattui's preferred vendor list to assist you with the coordination of rentals, timeline, vendors, etc.

## **How do I find accommodations for my guests?**

V. Sattui has compiled a list of hotels in the Napa Valley that will offer room blocks, and will provide you with hotel information to share with your guests.
